

n loving memory of Richard Coffie Sena Petershie also known as Daddy Coffie, whose life was a testament of faith, love, hard work and selflessness. He was born on Friday, the 29th of December 1972 at Accra New Town. Coffie hailed from the Petershie family of Avenorpeme in the Volta region of Ghana to her beloved parents Mr. Martin Kodjovi Petershie and Madam Victoria Akosua Kutor all of blessed memory. As the first born among the children, he assumed the leadership role and directed all the affairs of the family. A duty he discharged with passion and absolute alacrity.

A year after he was born, the parents moved from Accra New Town to Kaneshie where he lived for the greater part of growing years. He began his education with the Bethel Academy School, where he obtained the Basic Education Certificate. He later gained admission to Kaneshie Secondary Technical School (KATECO) from 1987 to 1992. He did very well and had the GCE 'O' LEVEL CERTIFICATE.

On completing KATECO, Sena was ready to continue with his ambition to become an engineer, but the untimely death of their father made it impossible for him to continue his dream. His mother therefore prevailed on him to hold on with his education and join her in the sausages production business so as to support the family.

Coffie became the man supporting the family till the mother also passed on years after.

Bro Coffie remained the father figure of his siblings and took care of them till his untimely demise on Monday, the 4^{th} of August 2023 after a short ailment at the UGMC, Legon - Accra.

Coffie was survived by five (5) siblings, five (5) children, a Complementing Wife of like mind and many family members and friends to mourn him.

A man of many ideas has passed on. We have lost a Hero, a Mentor, a man with a heart of Gold. A man of many positive sides.


